Training Course: Conflict Sensitive Development Practice

Duration: 5 Days

Schedule: Monday 19th July – Friday 23rd July 2010 (9.00am – 5.00pm each day)

Training Venue: Churchill Court Hotel, Gulu

Course Objective

By the end of the course, participants will have understood the concept of conflict sensitivity, able to integrate it into their projects, and implement, monitor and evaluate the impacts of their projects in the context of conflict.

Course Relevance

As Northern Uganda emerges from the two decades of armed conflicts, development partners are now focusing on implementing recovery and development programmes. Integrating conflict sensitivity into programmes will help avoid negative impacts, and maximize positive impacts of recovery and development programmes being implemented in the region. This is crucial in addressing conflicts at community level and also consolidating peace.

Course Content

- Introduction to conflict sensitive approaches to development
- Conflict analysis
- Applying conflict sensitivity into project (project cycles)
- Conflict sensitive implementation
- Conflict sensitive monitoring and evaluation
- Field visit and case analysis of conflict sensitive development project
- Institutional capacity building for conflict sensitivity

Target Group

This course is intended for development workers, NGO staff, local government staff, academicians, and students from tertiary institutions working in or intending to work in post-conflict contexts. This course is especially intended for people who are engaged or are planning to implement recovery and development programmes.

Training Cost

UGX 500,000 inclusive of refreshment, lunch, handouts, certificates, note books, and pens and field visit. Participants are responsible for their lodging and dinner. Limited concessions are available.

Number of Participants

The course will take a maximum 30 participants.
