## **Training Course: Conflict Sensitive Development Practice**

Duration: 3 Days  
Schedule: Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> – Friday 28<sup>th</sup> October 2011 (9.00am – 5.00pm)

### **Course Objective**

By the end of the course, participants will have understood the concept of conflict sensitivity, able to mainstream it into their projects, and implement, monitor and evaluate the impacts of their projects using a conflict lens.

### **Course Relevance**

As Northern Uganda emerges from the two decades of violent armed conflicts, development partners have refocused their attention from emergency intervention to recovery and development. This change in focus and the implementation of recovery and development programmes have not only achieved positive impact but also caused negation unintended impact as well as conflicts in the communities. Thus integrating conflict sensitivity into recovery and development programmes will help avoid negative impact, maximize positive impact, and address key conflict issues in the communities.
